

Diverse Literature Provides Windows, Mirrors, and Sliding Glass Doors

A window is a resource that offers you a view into someone else's experience. A mirror is a story that reflects your own culture and helps you build identity. A sliding glass door allows the reader to enter the story and become a part of that world...It is critical to understand that students cannot truly learn about themselves unless they learn about others, as well. – WEARETEACHERS Staff


