What is Social Justice? What Defines Social Justice Art?

Social Justice is the belief that everyone in society deserves equal social, economic and political rights; equal privileges; and equal opportunities...Social Justice depends on 4 essential goals: human rights, access, participation, and equity. Social Justice can't be achieved without these 4 principles.

Social justice art can be any expression of work related to public policy, racial inequity, injustice, human rights, or any other theme related to the oppression of a group of people. This art not only includes street artists' murals, but can include paintings, sculptures, film, theater, dance, music, written and spoken word, drawings, and digital graphics.

Social justice art is a form of artistic expression with a purpose. It serves as an outpouring of emotion reflecting how the community is feeling. These expressions often create a visual catalyst to engage community members in a conversation or encourage them to take certain action around the theme portrayed in the work of art.
